Maggie Dolan gave opening prayer

### **PARISH UPDATE**

Father Paul gave update with Easter coming up. 4 masses will be made available (7am, 8:30am, 10am, and 11:30)

Father spoke of the NEW IL legislation (in freedom of conscious) there will be a letter read at the upcoming weekends letter. There will be a meeting at Zion Benton Library at 6:30pm Tuesday 3/26 in re: to possible controversial topics, Father Paul spoke of.

Father Paul spoke of Parish Update in re: to the realigned groups (we are no longer paired with 3 total, but instead 2 total Parishes) now only St Patrick's and OLH will be paired together. Additional updates on possible changes should be given around Jan/Feb of 2020.

### **Parent Participation**

Miss Dolan announced to the Teachers at the last facility meeting that they will be covering recess duty next year, since this was removed from parent participation.

### **Principal Update**

Security Update: Waukegan Safe and Lock gave quote for push bars, locks, and new keying of the outside doors for \$18k, (this will be a paddle raiser at the auction). Tom asked if there will be a summary written up for the auction explaining why we are raising a paddle for these funds. OLH will be getting additional quotes for comparisons. Security key cards will not be updated till possibly next school year. The key fobs cannot be deployed until the outside locks are changed. Suggestion was made to possibly only replace a few locks and put blanks in the other doors for a cost savings. (Maggie to f/u)

School Calendar: School will start 8/21/2019 (Wed) for next school year, and school ending 6/5/2020 (Friday) (we have to have 180 school days). Parent/Teacher conferences will be the week of Thanksgiving. The light of the world will be in Oct 2019, kids will have that Friday off so set-up for the retreat can be completed. Maggie has to submit the upcoming school year calendar in the next few weeks.

Aspire Test: April 9 – 12 (5 total tests 1 test a day, with 2 tests on the last) for 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade (Math, English, Writing, Reading, Science)

Budget: Budget is currently being worked on. With the increase on minimum wage this will possibly cause an increase in tuition for the 2020/2021 school year. Budget update will be provided at the April meeting.
