# Thursday, April 2nd

### **PK3**

Religion: Please practice The Lord's Prayer by use of hand motions. Point up to the sky
when the words "Heaven" and "Kingdom" are said. Point down to the ground when the word
"Earth" is said. Practice making the Sign of the Cross. Close your eyes and think of three
people that you want to pray for. Say the words out loud, "Dear God, Please keep,
andsafe and healthy.
ELA: In your journals, have an older person help you write the names of the three people who
you prayed for and draw their pictures as best as you can. Somewhere on this same journal
page draw a large heart and have your parents help you write the word God on the inside of it.
Color the heart red. After you have done your journal picture watch the You Tube video by Jona

Talk about your favorite parts of the song and sing along. This song was chosen because it further makes us think about words that begin with the letter W, our letter of the week.

Math: Line up three stuffed animals in a row and call the one who is at the beginning of the line the "line leader." Then practice naming which animal would be first (the line leader), which would be last, and which would be "in the middle."

**Science/Social Studies:** In your journal as a second entry, draw an oval-shaped cloud. Color the cloud black or grey since it will be a rain cloud. Then draw ten circle raindrops falling from that oval-shaped rain cloud. Color the raindrops blue. The heading for the top will be: "W is for Weather, Rainy Weather."

Physical Activity: Pretend to be a raindrop and jump up, then fall to the ground. Do this ten times. After you have done this ten times, lay on the ground and kick your arms and legs around in many directions and say, "Look at me! Now I am a puddle!"
